## Leadership Team Meeting

**January 2026**

Jill presented November 2025 statistics and financials.

November had 20 acute days, 36 skilled days and outpatient visits/procedures of 2,832, LTC had 88% occupancy, and clinic volume at 899 visits. We had a total of 45 new patients from both clinics. We ended the month with a net loss; a few factors contributed to this; revenue was down across the board in most departments. In key departments like LTC they saw a significant drop in occupancy, RHC volume was low for this time of year, major ancillary areas like lab and radiology saw a decline in revenue as well. Surgery was an outlier that it saw a bump in volume and revenue. We are two months into the start of the interventional radiology clinic and they have seen two patients each of the months. Revenue is still exceeding prior year by 12% and expenses are up 5%.

Cheryl presented a review of the PTO Policy and Sick/Personal Leave Policies. Reminder to staff that time off for holidays is used from PTO bank.

Cheryl and Ashley presented information on launching our internal leadership academy. This is designed for developing and enhancing leadership skills for those in supervisory roles. Each session will last for approximately 10 months with a time commitment of 2 hours per month. More information coming soon on the course curriculum.

Rural health clinic construction continues and is on track for a completion date in June.
